

# Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station Decommissioning Forum

The purpose of the forum is to provide background information so that Duxbury citizens and other South Shore residents will understand what decommissioning involves, and can consider how decommissioning should proceed to best protect health, safety, and property values.

**The issues to be covered will include, for example:**

- What will happen to the nuclear waste?
- Who will pay for the clean-up, the licensee or taxpayers?
- How long will decommissioning take, the 60 years allowed by the NRC or less than that?
- How clean will the site be, and for what could it be used?
- Are all building to be taken down, or only some?
- Will Entergy sell Pilgrim to some other company to take over the cleanup; if so, what would that mean?

The Committee hopes that Duxbury's concerns will be brought forward at the upcoming first meeting of the state's **Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (NDCAP)**. Established by the legislature, the NDCAP is charged to be a conduit for public information, to encourage community involvement, and to receive reports on decommissioning and the decommissioning trust fund. **Its first public meeting will be on May 24, 2014, 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Plymouth South High School, 490 Long Pond Road, Plymouth. The NDCAP has invited public comments.**
