All sizes of the trees will be on display on the table. If there are any trees left for sale, they will be sold at the Duxbury Holly Days Event in November. There will still be a tree pick-up day at the Senior Center on November 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>.

Marion will place articles in the Duxbury Clipper about the sale at Foodie's. It might be good to include that it will be a "Meet the Artist" opportunity.

**DCC Grants:** Grants are due by October 15<sup>th</sup>. Marion will also puts two articles in the Clipper announcing that grant money is available and a second notice advising the deadline is nearing.
