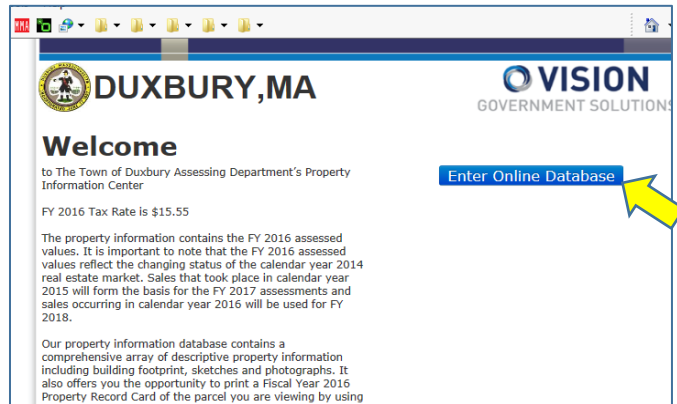


How to View the FEMA Maps Online: Duxbury's GIS

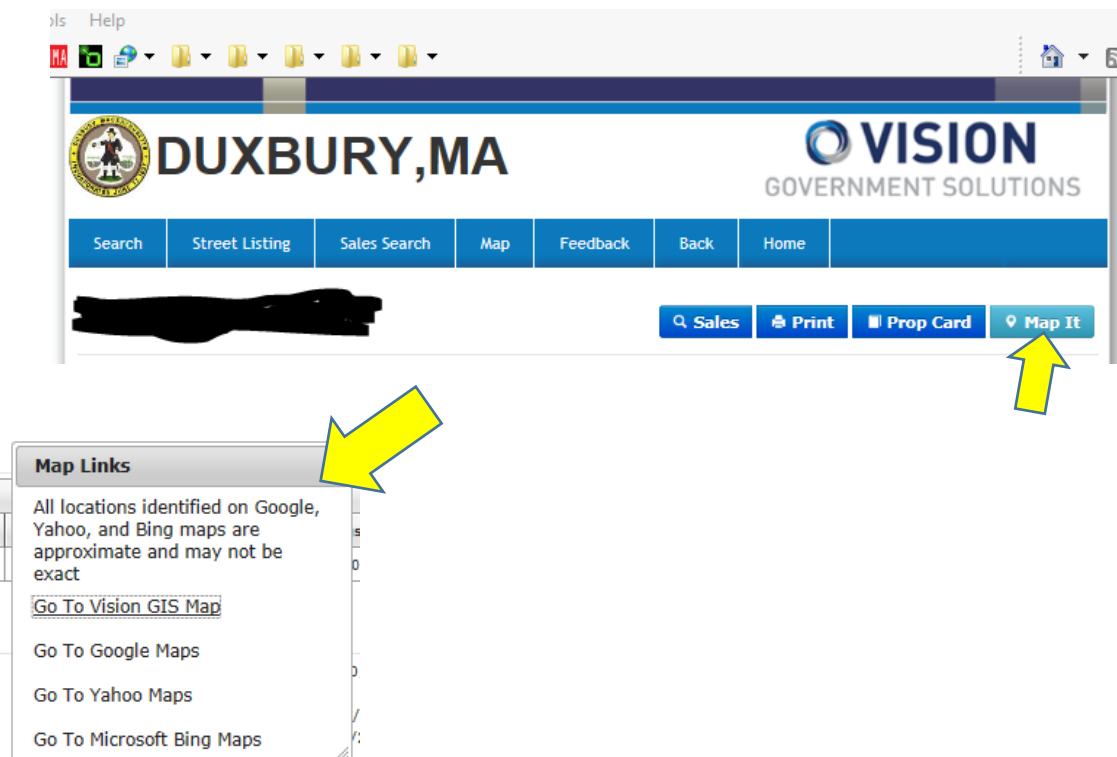
To use the Town's GIS system to view your property:

There are two sets of maps posted on the Town's GIS mapping system,

Press the "enter online database" button, then type in your address in the search window. You will be brought here, where you can select what you want to see. Select the "Map It" button, which will bring up Map Links – choose "Go To Vision GIS Map."

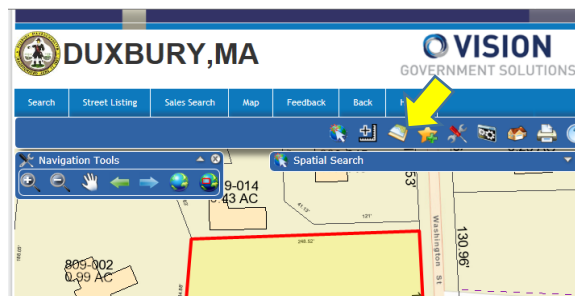


Congratulations – we are almost there!

Now you press the small triangle at the top right to close the property record so you can view the map (see right) – your parcel will be highlighted in yellow (see below).



Add the new flood panel information by going to the base map layer button – an icon that looks like two overlapped squares:



In a few seconds, a drop down menu will appear. Scroll down until you see FEMA 11-2016 Revised Preliminary SFHA, then check the little white box at the left. Once checked, the flood map “layer” is turned on. Close the Legend with the small triangle so you can see the map. From here you can zoom in or out until you see the labels identifying the mapped flood areas, by color. Your property will remain outlined in red. You can also turn on the 2012 (current) maps in the same way; this layer is named FEMA Flood Hazard Overlay.
