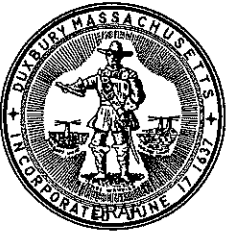

# Town of Duxbury Community Preservation Committee

## MINUTES OF AUGUST 11, 2022

The Duxbury Community Preservation Committee (CPC) met in person on Thursday, August 11, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. in the Town Hall Mural Room.

Chair, Holly Morris called the Community Preservation Committee to order at 8:30 a.m.

### **Discussion regarding increasing the CPA surcharge to 3%:**

Holly Morris generated and distributed the following series of handouts: Community Preservation Act, Duxbury History; The Community Preservation Act – Purpose; Goals of the Open Space and Recreation Plan; Open Space Projects and CPA Funds spent; Historic Preservation Projects and CPA fund spent; Community Housing, projects and CPA funds spent; Recreation, projects and CPA funds spent; What We Have Accomplished with CPA (2002-2022); Outpouring of Community Support; Exemptions; If We Remain at 1% Surcharge; Duxbury CPA revenue FY2012 – FY 2023 Est. And, Duxbury CPA Surcharge Receipts and State Match Compared with Receipts if No Reduction in Surcharge and CPA Surcharge Comps 2, 2.5%, 3% based upon Adams Attestation for Fall 2022.

The fall 3% campaign will be six weeks, beginning at Labor Day and ending at Special Town Meeting on October 17, 2022.

- Information session/s at Senior Center (Tony)
- Solicit support of First Parish Church (Cindy)

At 9:45 a.m. Tony Kelso made a motion, seconded by Kathy Cross, to adjourn the Community Preservation Committee meeting. Motion passed unanimously 5 to 0.
