Town Meeting warrant. They described the nature of the bylaw, what types of bags it would ban, and the impacts of these types of bags on the environment.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the Commission voted to support the article on the Town Meeting warrant to ban plastic shopping bags in Duxbury. The motion was made by Sam Butcher, seconded by Mickey McGonagle, and was passed by a vote of 5-0-0.
