Minutes: April 1, 2020

3. Public Hearing: 226 Powder Point Avenue

A roll call vote on a motion to "postpone the advertised Public Hearing to consider a proposal submitted to the Commission for the total demolition of a barn/carriage house constructed ca. 1900, located at 226 Powder Point Ave., Parcel 134/080/215 owned by George P. Whitelaw to a date, time and place certain" passed unanimously, 5-0. The public hearing was considered closed.

- **4. Next meeting.** The next regularly scheduled meeting is April 15. The current plan is to have this broadcast using ZOOM and PAC TV so it will be available to the public. The desired start time is 3:00 PM if that PAC TV time slot is still available.
