Public Statement on the Temporary Closure of The Anchor Restaurant at 289 St. George Street in Duxbury MA

October 6, 2020

The Duxbury Board of Health received notification on October 6, 2020, from the owner of The Anchor that an employee at The Anchor located at 289 St. George Street in Duxbury, MA, tested positive for COVID-19. The restaurant closed upon finding this out and has been closed for the 24 hours required to perform a thorough cleaning and disinfecting in accordance with current CDC guidance before re-opening.

The employee is known to have worked on October 2nd and October 3rd.

The Duxbury Board of Health and The Anchor are following state protocol and have already notified anyone known to have had close contact with the employee that tested positive. If you have any concerns, as always, contact your primary care provider for advice on getting tested.
