# I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:00pm in the Duxbury Schools' Performing Arts Center located at 73 Alden Street.

## II. NEW BUSINESS

Discussion regarding new Parking Violation Fines & Procedures – presented by Chief Matthew Clancy and Deputy Chief Stephen McDonald

Chief Clancy and Deputy Chief McDonald informed the Selectmen that the Police Department will be taking over the processing of parking violations. They have a contract with a new vendor which will modernize the process by tracking fines, late fees, and direct connection to the Registry of Motor Vehicles. The proposed increase in the fines is within the guidelines of MGL c. 90 Section 20A ½.

Mr. Madigan moved that the Board of Selectmen approve and adopt the proposed increase in parking violation fines, as requested in a memorandum from Chief Matthew Clancy dated August 29, 2018, and subject to the limits under MGL c. 90 Section 20A ½. Seconded by Mr. Dahlen. Vote: 3:0:0

### Discussion regarding 74 Bay Road - Chapter 61A

A portion of this property contains land categorized under Chapter 61A, which gives the Selectmen a right of first refusal. Both the Conservation Commission and the Planning Board have recommended that the Selectmen do not exercise their right of first refusal.

# Lot 3 (excluding excepted portions and Parcel A)

Mr. Madigan moved that the Board of Selectmen do not exercise their right of first refusal for the parcel known as Lot 3 and shown on an ANR Plan of Land at 74 Bay Road, Duxbury, MA 02332 entitled "Remaining Land of Darin P. Eddy, Myrna L. Henry and Joseph J. O'Donnell" containing approximately 9.062 acres, which are part of the Assessor's Parcel ID #110-830-003. Seconded by Mr. Dahlen. Vote: 3:0:0

### Parcel A

Mr. Madigan moved that the Board of Selectmen do not exercise their right of first refusal for the parcel shown on an ANR Plan of Land at 74 Bay Road, Duxbury, MA 02332 entitled "Parcel A" containing approximately 1.50 acres, which are part of the Assessor's Parcel ID #110-830-003. Seconded by Mr. Dahlen. Vote: 3:0:0

*Discussion regarding Article 7 – Memorandum of Understanding from Ditch Digger LLC (ICO)*Mr. Madigan moved that the Board of Selectmen approve of agree to the terms and conditions of this Memorandum of Understanding between Ditch Digger LLC and the Town of Duxbury, as presented. Seconded by Mr. Dahlen. Vote: 3:0:0
