Tips for accessing MACRIS

This database can be tricky to use. If you enter information in a way that does not exactly match what the database already has, you will come up empty. To avoid that, follow these instructions.

- The first time you visit, you will see a "MACRIS Terms and Disclaimer" page.
 - On the bottom of the page
 - Tick the box labeled "This is not a public or shared computer, remember my acknowledgement"
 - Click the "Acknowledge and Accept Terms" button.
- On the following page, use the "Search Filter" menu on the left.
 - Click the "Refine by City/Town" link and use the "View List" button to select Duxbury
 - Click NEXT
 - Click the "Refine by Address" link and use the "View List" button to select your Street
 - Click NEXT
- A listing of all the buildings on your street will appear. Find yours!
- Click on the blue "INV" icon to download a copy of your home's historical survey report.
