## SUBJECT: FUND COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

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## SUBJECT: PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE RELATED TO PURCHASE OF RICKER PROPERTY

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$600,000.00 to pay off debt service on outstanding balances, including bond anticipation notes, related to the purchase of the Ricker Property; originally approved by way of Article 2 of the Special Town Meeting held on October 17, 2022; and to meet said appropriation, transfer the sums of \$585,347.14 from the Sale of Real Estate fund and \$14,652.86 from Community Preservation Undesignated Fund Balance.

## SUBJECT: OTHER POST EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS (OPEB)

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$300,000.00 to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund (OPEB) and, to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of \$300,000.00 from Free Cash to such fund.

### **SUBJECT: STABILIZATION FUND**

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$250,000.00 to the Stabilization Fund and, to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of \$250,000.00 from Free Cash to such fund.

### SUBJECT: ACCRUED LIABILITIES AND COMPENSATED ABSENCES FUND

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$125,000.00 to the Accrued Liabilities and Compensated Absences Fund, and to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of \$125,000.00 from Free Cash to such fund.

### **SUBJECT: MATCHING GRANT FUNDS**

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$250,000.00 and, to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of \$250,000.00 from Free Cash, to be expended under the direction of the Selectboard and/or Town Manager to be used to provide for the Town's local match gifts and/or grants committed to and/or received by the Town from time to time.
