Public Statement on the Temporary Closure of The Oysterman Restaurant at 30 Railroad Avenue in Duxbury MA

October 1, 2020

The Duxbury Board of Health received notification late in the afternoon of September 30, 2020, from the Department of Public Health, that an employee at The Oysterman Restaurant, located at 30 Railroad Ave in Duxbury, MA, had tested positive for COVID-19. The Duxbury Board of Health contacted The Oysterman Restaurant for immediate 24-hour closure and instructed The Oysterman to perform a thorough cleaning and disinfecting in accordance with current CDC guidance before re-opening.

The employee is known to have worked on September 27th and 28th.

The Duxbury Board of Health and The Oysterman are following state protocol in notifying any persons known to have had close contact with the employee that tested positive. It is recommended that anyone who visited The Oysterman at Railroad Avenue on September 27th and 28th contact their primary care provider for advice on getting tested.
