Local Historic District Commission Meeting February 23, 2021

Attending: Renée Mierzejewski, Chair, Janet Ritch, William McArdle, Georgia Taft-Pye

Renee Mierzejewski called the meeting to order at 7:29 p.m. and read the remote meeting preamble. She then opened a Public Hearing for the purpose of confirming that there is no public objection to placing the following properties into Local Historic Districts:

- 900 Tremont Street – Bradford Local Historic District
- 14 Powder Point Avenue – Powder Point Local Historic District
- 397 and 405 Washington Street – Winsor Local Historic District
- 245 Summer Street – Tarkiln Local Historic District

There was no public objection and these properties will be on a Warrant Article submitted for Town Meeting 2021 for voting for acceptance as Local Historic Districts.

Renée announced that Valerie had been in touch to say that there was no need to review the Warrant Article to possibly change language in the By-Law for the maps. Valerie said that this question had been taken care of.

Selectmen candidates Fernando Guitart and Michael McGee addressed the group and expressed their interest and support for the Local Historic District Commission. Selectman Amy McNab agreed and voiced her support. She suggested that perhaps Fernando or Michael might want to be the Selectman Liaison for the Local Historic District Commission.

Renée thanked the candidates and Amy McNabb for attending for their support for the Commission.

She proposed that the review of LHDC rules and regulations be postponed to the March meeting.

That proposal was accepted by unanimous vote.

Janet Ritch moved that the meeting be adjourned. With a unanimous vote the meeting was adjourned at 8:01 p.m.
