


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

The Master Plan gives the town:



Overarching Themes

Change is Happening. The Master Plan is an opportunity for the Town to positively shape that change, specifically responding to: Land use and development changes, demographic trends, climate changes.

Unique but Connected. Dependent on the broader conditions of the subregion and metropolitan Boston with growing regional and local trends in working from home and entrepreneurship.


Safe Walking and Biking. Community survey showed strong preferences for increasing walking and biking in Duxbury. Walking and biking have grown as high demand and high benefit activities, particularly in and around neighborhood business districts.

Coastal Resilience. Coastal resilience and sustainability efforts are a present need, not that of a distant future. Sea level rise puts an estimated \$12M of commercial property at risk in Duxbury, impacts coastal homes and historic properties, and has potential impacts to shellfish industry and natural functions in Duxbury Bay.

Stewardship and Legacy. Carry forward the legacy of the Town including the history, cultural sites, historic homes, dedication to conservation and the environment.
