PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Duxbury Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing in the Mural Meeting Room on the lower level of Town Hall, under the Town of Duxbury Wetlands Bylaw, Chapter 9 and Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, MGL, Ch. 131, Section 40, on Tuesday evening, January 23, 2024 at 7:01pm at the request of Weston & Sampson Engineers to perform investigative test pits at the former McNeil dump facility located adjacent to the Duxbury Municipal Landfill and Transfer Station as described in a Notice of Intent filed with the Conservation Commission on December 29, 2023. Said project is located at 155 Mayflower Street (Lot #092-500-039), 0 Mayflower Street (Lot #093-500-041), and 0 Mayflower Street (093-500-431) of the Duxbury Assessors Map.
