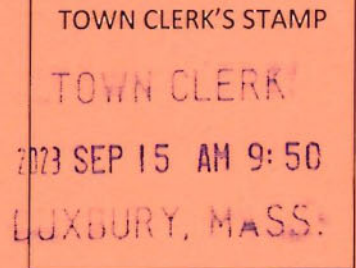

ZBA Case # 2023-18 McLaughlin, 685 Washington Street, Remand Order: Remand Order from the Land Court dated August 24, 2023 (the "Remand Order") in John McLaughlin v. Duxbury Zoning Board of Appeals, Civil Action No. 19 MISC. 000109. Pursuant to the Remand Order, the Zoning Board of Appeals shall consider whether the imposition of reasonable conditions is warranted for the proposed residential pier on the Plaintiff's property at 685 Washington Street, Duxbury and shall issue the special permit requested by the Plaintiff as ordered by the Land Court and affirmed by the Appeals Court in Case No. 22-P-803.
