1. Request for Extension to Disposal Construction Permits for 387-397 North Street  
Applicant John Baldwin

310 CMR 15.020(3) The local approving authority or the Department may issue a written one year extension to the Disposal System Construction permit required by 310 CMR 15.020(1) upon written request of the permittee, filed before the expiration date, and documenting the facts that prevent completion of the approved system within the time of the original permit. Only one extension may be granted.

Title 5 local upgrade approval to 310 CMR 15.405 (1) (b) for approval to increase the maximum allowable depth of system components required by 310 CMR 15.221(7) to allow the tanks to be located 6 feet below grade instead of 3 feet.

Title 5 local upgrade approval from 310 CMR 405(1)(g) for approval to decrease the distance from a soil absorption system to a water supply line required by 310 CMR 15.211 (1) from 10 feet to greater than 5 feet. A 40 mil. Liner will be provided anywhere the distance between the system and water line is less than 10 feet.

local upgrade approval from 310 CMR 15.405 (1)(k) for approval to perform only 1 deep hole in the soil absorption area, where 2 deep holes is required by 310 CMR 15.102(2). The soil absorption system is in the reserve area, which has previously been tested and the one deep hole adequately characterizes the soils for the purpose of designing the system.
