TOTAL DEMOLITION
OF A STRUCTURE AT
308 SUMMER STREET

In accordance with the Duxbury Zoning Bylaws Section 609.3, the Duxbury Historical Commission will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 13, 2019, at 7:10 p.m. in the Small Meeting Room, Lower Level, at Duxbury Town Hall located at 878 Tremont Street, Duxbury, MA 02332 to consider a proposal submitted to the Commission for the **total demolition** of a single-family structure constructed ca. 1887, located at 308 Summer Street Parcel 031/048/002 owned by June Delprete.

A copy of the *Application for Structure Demolition Permit* has been filed with the Town Clerk and is available for review at the Duxbury Free Library, in the Board of Selectmen/Town Manager's Office and in the Municipal Services Department.

All residents and interested parties may attend the meeting.
