The Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing in the Mural Room at Town Hall, 878 Tremont Street, on Thursday, May 24, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. to consider the application of Chiu Wei-Chi for an Appeal under Article (s) 400, 600 and 900, Section (s) 430, 611, 615 and 906.1 of the Duxbury Protective Bylaw.
