

EMERGENCY SIRENS TO BE TESTED Thursday, November 15

There will be a **TEST** of the Prompt Alert Notification System (a system of sirens) in the 10-mile area around Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station on **Thursday, November 15, 2018 beginning at 3:45 p.m.**

The test will consist of a **steady, three-minute siren tone beginning at 3:45 p.m.**

There will be no reason for the public to take any action during the test.



IT IS SIMPLY A TEST.



The siren system is in place to alert the public in the unlikely event of an emergency at Pilgrim Station, or to alert the public within the 10-mile area of any other emergency. In the unlikely event of a real emergency, the sounding of the sirens would mean that the public should monitor one of the following Emergency Alert System (EAS) radio stations for official information:

WBZ AM (Boston) -- 1030 WPLM FM (Plymouth) -- 99.1
WATD FM (Marshfield) -- 95.9 WBZ FM (Boston) -- 98.5
