## **EMERGENCY SIRENS**

TO BE TESTED

## **Thursday, November 16**

There will be a <u>TEST</u> of the Prompt Alert Notification System (a system of sirens) in the 10-mile area around Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station on <u>Thursday, November 16, 2017 beginning at 3:45 p.m.</u>
The test will consist of a steady, three-minute siren tone beginning at 3:45 p.m.

There will be no reason for the public to take any action during the test.



IT IS SIMPLY A TEST.



The siren system is in place to alert the public in the unlikely event of an emergency at Pilgrim Station, or to alert the public within the 10-mile area of any other emergency. In the unlikely event of a real emergency, the sounding of the sirens would mean that the public should monitor one of the following Emergency Alert System (EAS) radio stations for official information:

**WBZ AM** (Boston) -- 1030 **WPLM AM** (Plymouth) -- 1390 **WATD FM** (Marshfield) -- 95.9 **WPLM FM** (Plymouth) -- 99.1 **WBZ FM** (Boston) -- 98.5
