

# **EMERGENCY SIRENS**

## **TO BE TESTED**

### **Thursday, November 16**

There will be a **TEST** of the Prompt Alert Notification System (a system of sirens) in the 10-mile area around Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station on **Thursday, November 16, 2017 beginning at 3:45 p.m.** The test will consist of a **steady, three-minute siren tone beginning at 3:45 p.m.**

**There will be no reason for the public to take any action during the test.**



**IT IS SIMPLY A TEST.**



The siren system is in place to alert the public in the unlikely event of an emergency at Pilgrim Station, or to alert the public within the 10-mile area of any other emergency. In the unlikely event of a real emergency, the sounding of the sirens would mean that the public should monitor one of the following Emergency Alert System (EAS) radio stations for official information:

<b>WBZ AM</b> (Boston) -- 1030	<b>WPLM AM</b> (Plymouth) -- 1390
<b>WATD FM</b> (Marshfield) -- 95.9	<b>WPLM FM</b> (Plymouth) -- 99.1
<b>WBZ FM</b> (Boston) -- 98.5
