## **Community Preservation Committee**

#### Dear Applicant:

The Town of Duxbury is pleased to be able to offer the opportunity to apply for Community Preservation Act funds. These funds are available for the following purposes:

- the acquisition, creation and preservation of open space
- the acquisition and preservation of historical resources
- > the acquisition, creation or preservation of land for recreational use
- > the creation, preservation and support of community housing
- the rehabilitation or restoration of such open space, historic resources, land for recreational use and community housing that is acquired or created as provided in this section.

Use of Community Preservation Act funds may not include

- > maintenance of real or personal property
- > use of land for a stadium, gymnasium or similar structure.

The full text of the Community Preservation Act can be found in M.G.L. 44B, Chapter 267 of the Acts of 2000. Copies are available at the Town Hall, Duxbury Free Library and online at: <u>https://malegislature.gov/Laws/GeneralLaws/Partl/TitleVII/Chapter44B</u>

In an effort to provide equal consideration to all, the Community Preservation Committee (CPC) has devised the attached application. We ask that you include with your application a proposal for your project. Your proposal should include

- > a full description of the project including estimated costs, photographs, plot plans, maps (if applicable)
- the amount of funding requested
- > other possible sources of funding
- > a projected timeline
- a brief narrative indicating how your proposal benefits the Town of Duxbury and meets the goals of the Community Preservation Act.

In order for the Community Preservation Committee to process your request, you must complete the Request Form and attach it to your proposal. **All applications for consideration by the CPC must be received no later than** <u>**October 15**<sup>th</sup></u>. The scope of the project must be discussed in detail, allowing the CPC sufficient time for review before the December closing of the annual town meeting warrant. Return four (4) copies to:

Community Preservation Committee c/o Conservation Department 878 Tremont Street Duxbury, MA 02332 or deliver it directly to the Conservation Department, Duxbury Town Hall. Your proposal will be reviewed by the CPC.
