## MEDICARE PART B PREMIUMS 2024

The Medicare Part B premiums for 2024 have been announced. The standard premium is being increased from $\$ 164.90$ to $\$ 174.70$, an increase of $\$ 9.80$. As you may remember, last year's premium decreased by $\$ 5.20$. Please see the announcement from CMS: https://www.cms.gov/newsroom/fact-sheets/2024-medicare-parts-b-premiums-and-deductibles

As you are aware, there will be an Income Related Adjustment Amount (IRMAA) for those individuals earning greater than $\$ 103,000$ per year (up from $\$ 97,000$ in 2023) or greater than $\$ 206,000$ per year (up from $\$ 194,000$ in 2023) if filing a joint tax return.

## Medicare Part B Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amounts

Since 2007, a beneficiary's Part B monthly premium is based on his or her income. These income-related monthly adjustment amounts affect roughly 8 percent of people with Medicare Part B. The 2024 Part B total premiums for high-income beneficiaries with full Part B coverage are shown in the following table.
