



## Bay Farm

Long before the first Duxbury landowners began farming these fields in 1627, Native Americans occupied this area. Three centuries later, this property was owned by the Bay Farm Company which raised dairy cows, bulls, heifers, horses, hogs, and chickens. The majority of Bay Farm is now open field and is managed for recreation and field nesting birds, such as bobolink and woodcock. At the end of the field, you will be rewarded with beautiful views of Kingston Bay.

**Property Details:** 44 acres. 1.4 miles of trails:  
Southern terminus of the (White) Bay Circuit Trail, a 200+ mile trail from Duxbury to Newburyport

**Vegetation:** Cedar forest, wetlands shrubs and grasses, wet meadow, open field

**Features:** Open field; Views of Kingston Bay; Coastal beach; Rock ledge

**Terrain:** Easy - Relatively flat

**Parking:** Lot with is located on the east side of Loring St.
