



Thaddeus Chandler Sanctuary

Once a farm operated by Thaddeus Chandler, a Civil War veteran, the farm contained cranberry bogs and a sawmill for processing wood from his extensive woodlots. The property contains a 1.3 mile loop trail as well as many spurs and connecting trails, suitable for all skill levels.

Property Details: 115 acres

2.8 miles of trails: Blue Loop: 1.3 miles

Vegetation: Eastern white pine, red and white oak, red maple; wetland grasses and shrubs

Features: Upper Chandler Pond; Flowing brooks; Remains of the cranberry industry ditches

Terrain: Easy-Moderate - Relatively flat with some hills on the east side

Parking: Roadside parking along Valley Street
