



Gifford Bog & Williams Preserve

Gifford Bog is the oldest working bog in Duxbury dating to c.1855.

Property Details: 22 acres

Features: Cranberry bogs

Terrain: Easy around working bogs

Parking: Roadside parking along Temple Street

Williams Preserve homestead was built c.1911 by Jack Williams who lived there for nearly 92 years. Jack worked the bog, managed the Christmas tree farm, and enjoyed wildlife. Williams trails course along the Wright Reservoir, a cranberry bog, and wooded uplands.

Property Details: 200 acres

2.3 miles of trails: Blue Loop: 1.7 miles

Vegetation: Eastern white pine, red and white oak, wetland shrubs, cranberry bogs

Features: Cranberry bogs; Wright Reservoir; Williams' former Christmas tree farm

Terrain: Easy around the bogs, moderate in the woodlands

Parking: Lot located on Frontage Road, off of Church St.
