



Duxbury Bogs

This area was purchased by the town in 1971 to preserve Duxbury's agricultural heritage. The bog reservoir offers habitat to a wide variety of waterfowl, especially during migration. The Bay Circuit Trail runs North-South through the property.

Property Details: 198 acres. 4.5 miles of trails:

White (Bay Circuit Trail): 0.8 miles

Vegetation: Eastern white pine, red and white oak, wetlands shrubs, cranberry bogs

Features: Cranberry bogs; Glacial topography; Reservoir views

Terrain: Easy-Moderate - Cart paths, network of cranberry ditches and dikes, some trails ascend steep topography

Parking: Lot located on the north side of East Street
