SUBJECT: FUND COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

<u>Union Contract – Town of Duxbury Firefighters</u>

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of **\$89,996.00** for the purpose of funding a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Duxbury Permanent Firefighter's Association, International Association of Firefighters Local 2167 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and to meet this appropriation, transfer **\$89,996.00** from Free Cash.

Union Contract - Town of Duxbury School Teachers

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$80,000.00</u> for the purpose of funding a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Duxbury Teachers Association for fiscal year beginning July 1 2016 and ending June 30, 2017, and to meet this appropriation, transfer <u>\$80,000.00</u> from Free Cash.

SUBJECT: FUND COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

<u>Union Contract – Town of Duxbury Laborers</u>

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$44,805.00</u> for the purpose of funding a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Duxbury Municipal Employees, AFSCME, Council 93, Local 1700, Duxbury DPW Employees for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017, and to meet this appropriation, transfer <u>\$33,123.00</u> from Free Cash, and <u>\$11,682.00</u> from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings.

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SUBJECT: FUND COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

<u>Union Contract – Town of Duxbury Public Safety</u> <u>Dispatchers</u>

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$8,530.00</u> for the purpose of funding a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Duxbury Police Dispatchers Union MCOP Local 376A for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017, and to meet this appropriation, transfer <u>\$8,530.00</u> from Free Cash.

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ARTICLE 4 2/3 Vote Required

SUBJECT: CPC: CONSERVATION LAND PURCHASE

I move that the Town, upon recommendation of the Community Preservation Committee acquire by purchase, gift or eminent domain, on terms that the Board of Selectmen deems to be in the best interests of the Town, for open space purposes under the care and custody of the Conservation Commission as defined in M.G.L. Chapter 40, Section 8C, fee simple interest, encumbered with a permanent restriction pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 184, in a parcel of land, approximately $17.4\pm$ acres, as shown on a plan of land on file at the Office of the Town Clerk and identified as 086-015-012 as shown on the Duxbury maps, and to the appropriate Assessors of sum \$252,000.00 for the purposes of this article, including land acquisition and any costs related thereto, and to meet this appropriation, transfer money from the Undesignated

Fund Balance of the Community Preservation Fund the sum of <u>\$152,000.00</u>, and transfer from the Open Space Reserve of the Community Preservation Fund the sum of <u>\$100,000.00</u>, and further to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into certain agreements on terms deemed by the Selectmen to be in the best interest of the Town, and to authorize the Town Manager to expend sums of money pursuant to this article.

SUBJECT: PERCY WALKER POOL ENTERPRISE <u>FUND</u>

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of \$3,620.00 to supplement appropriations previously voted under Article 5 at the Annual Town Meeting on March 12, 2016 for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2016 for the Percy Walker Pool Enterprise Fund, and to meet said appropriation transfer the sum of <u>\$3,620.00</u> from the Personnel Plan appropriation approved under Article 4 of the March 12, 2016 Annual Town Meeting.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 3-0 Finance Committee Vote – 5-0

SUBJECT: REVOKE THE ENTERPRISE PROVISIONS OF M.G.L.'S PERTAINING TO THE PERCY WALKER POOL

I move that the Town revoke the acceptance of provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 44, Section 53F¹/₂, terminating the Percy Walker Pool Enterprise Fund as of June 30, 2017.

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SUBJECT: CPC: ALLOCATIONS

I move that the Town, upon recommendation of the Community Preservation Committee, transfer the sum of **§2,403.00** from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the Community Preservation Fund for the purpose of meeting the requirements of the Community Preservation Act, M.G.L. Chapter 44B, Section 6, with **§801.00** of said amount reserved for Open Space, **§801.00** of said amount reserved for Community Housing (Affordable), and **§801.00** of said amount reserved for Historic Resources (Preservation), said funds to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager.

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SUBJECT: PEG ACCESS AND CABLE RELATED FUND ACCEPTANCE

I move that the Town accept M.G.L. Chapter 44, Section 53F ³/₄ to establish a special revenue fund known as the Public Educational and Governmental ("PEG") Access and Cable Related Fund to reserve cable franchise fees and other cable-related revenues for appropriation to support PEG access services, oversight, and renewal of the cable franchise agreement, the fund to begin operation in Fiscal Year 2018, beginning on July 1, 2017.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 3-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

SUBJECT: FIRE PUMPING ENGINE FUNDING

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$200,000.00</u> to pay the outstanding temporary debt associated with the purchase of the Fire Pumping Engine, and to meet this appropriation, transfer <u>\$200,000.00</u> from Free Cash to the Fire Pumping Engine Capital Project Fund.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

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SUBJECT: NORTH HILL COUNTRY CLUB COURT JUDGMENT FUNDING

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$435,000.00</u> to pay the outstanding temporary debt associated with the North Hill Country Club court judgment, and to meet this appropriation, transfer <u>\$435,000.00</u> from Free Cash.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 5-0-1

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SUBJECT: SPECIAL EDUCATION RESERVE FUND ACCEPTANCE

I move that the Town accept M.G.L. Chapter 40, Section 13E to establish a reserve fund for the payment of future unanticipated or unbudgeted costs of special education, out-of-district tuition, or transportation, and further to transfer <u>\$400,000.00</u> from Free Cash to such fund to be expended under the direction of the School Committee.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

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SUBJECT: PENSION RESERVE FUND

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$50,000.00</u> to the Pension Reserve Fund, and to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of <u>\$50,000.00</u> from Free Cash to such fund.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

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SUBJECT: OTHER POST-EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS (OPEB)

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$300,000.00</u> to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund (OPEB), and to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of <u>\$300,000.00</u> from Free Cash to such fund.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

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SUBJECT: STABILIZATION FUND

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$100,000.00</u> to the Stabilization Fund, and to meet said appropriation, transfer the sum of <u>\$100,000.00</u> from Free Cash to such fund.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 7-0

SUBJECT: ACCRUED LIABILITIES AND COMPENSATED ABSENCES FUND

I move that the Town appropriate the sum of <u>\$100,000.00</u> to the Accrued Liabilities and Compensated Absences Fund, and to meet said appropriation, transfer <u>\$100,000.00</u> from Free Cash to such fund, to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager.

Recommendations: Board of Selectmen Vote – 2-0 Finance Committee Vote – 6-0

ARTICLE 16 2/3 Vote Required

SUBJECT: APPLICATION OF BOND PREMIUM

I move that the Town supplement each prior vote of the Town that authorized the borrowing of money to pay costs of capital projects to provide that, in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 44, Section 20, the premium received by the Town upon the sale of any bonds or notes thereunder, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bond or notes, may be applied to pay project costs and the amount authorized to the borrowed for each such project shall be reduced by the amount of any such premium so applied.
